- Preventive health education for youth and young adults.

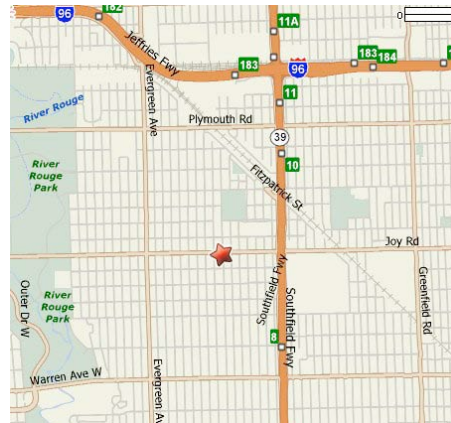

Available Services Include

- Free or low-cost home repairs for low-income, single family, homeowners in the Joy-Southfield service area (Evergreen Road to Southfield Freeway; Warren Ave to Plymouth Rd). The program operates three times per year.
- Acquisition, rehabilitation and affordable resale of vacant homes. Please contact us if you know of a property suitable for renovation.
- Home Foreclosure Prevention Counseling. In collaboration with Southwest Solutions, we offer free home foreclosure counseling at our location on Wednesdays.
- Home ownership education. Topics include how to apply for a mortgage, simple home repairs, preparing a household budget, & credit repair.

Available Services Include

- Commercial property façade improvement program. Through a partnership with the City of Detroit Mayor's Office of Commercial Revitalization (ONCR), local business owners can apply for free architectural consultations and matching funds for eligible façade improvements through the ReFresh Detroit! program. The Joy-Southfield ReFresh Detroit! district extends on Joy Road from Evergreen Road to Southfield Freeway.
- Strategic planning for commercial revitalization. Joy-Southfield is working with several partners to develop a strategic blueprint for revitalizing the Joy-Southfield commercial neighborhood. Partners include ONCR (see above), the Skillman Foundation Good Neighborhoods Initiative, Warrendale Community Organization and Joy Community Association. Other partnerships are currently being pursued.
